Available for all grade levels, the *Picturing Kansas* tour explores the permanent collection of the Beach Museum of Art and investigates how artists have depicted the Kansas prairies and farmlands. This fall's new installation includes unique ¾ size photographs of prairie tall grass roots by Jim Richardson.



Tours have language arts, social studies or science ties; activities develop 21st Century Skills of critical thinking, creativity, communication, and collaboration. Weather permitting; students can visit The Meadow for additional inspiration.
