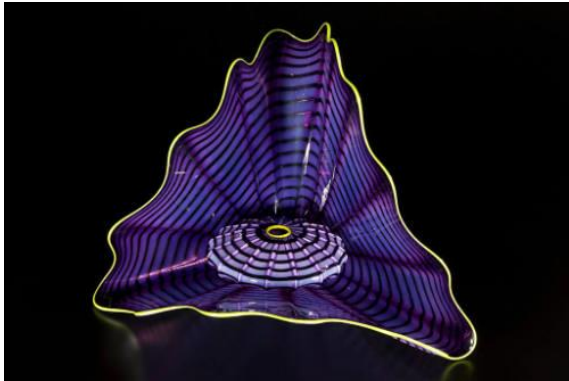


ELEMENTARY GRADE LEVELS, FEBRUARY 25-AUGUST 30, 2025
