

SCHOOL TOURS GRADES K-6



Students will develop language arts and observation skills while exploring art pairings of animals from the permanent collection. In addition to compare and contrast activities, participants will learn more about how animals are used in cultural art, Spanish vocabulary, and a bit of zoology.

Each student will create an animal poem and artwork to take home.
