Build visual literacy and language art skills on a magical tour of art from the Beach Museum of Art's permanent collection. Students will use Visual Thinking Strategies, a facilitated critical and evidence-based reasoning discussion method to create their own stories. Older students will participate in writing activities based on Trevor and Andrew Bryan's, *The Art of Comprehension: Exploring Visual Texts to Foster Comprehension, Conversation and Confidence*. Everyone will make a decorative writing journal to take home.

Tours are free, available Tuesday-Friday, last 1½ hours.
